Sport Scheme F.A.Q.s

What age does my child have to be to go swimming?

Children must be aged 8 or over to go swimming as part of the Sport Scheme.

Do they have to be able to swim?

No, but non-swimmers must stay in the shallow end.

If a child wants to swim in the deep end, they must demonstrate they can confidently swim **2 lengths** of the pool. This will be observed by a **lifeguard** and a **Sport Caerphilly coach**.

Do children have to go swimming? What if they don't want to?

No, swimming is **optional**.

If your child doesn't want to swim, they will stay in the **sports hall** and take part in **other sporting activities** with coaches and volunteers.

What activities are delivered?

A variety of sports are offered each day. Activities may include:

- Football
- Dodgeball
- Rounders
- Cricket
- Netball
- Badminton
- Frisbee
- Rugby
- Basketball
- And more!

Each day's schedule may vary.

Do children need to bring money?

There are vending machines at each site, but **children are responsible** for their own money and valuables. Staff cannot look after these items.

What should children wear?

- Sporty clothing suitable for physical activity
- Trainers or suitable footwear
- Wet weather gear (jacket/waterproofs), as some activities may take place outside *If weather conditions are very poor, all activities will be held indoors.*

Is lunch provided?

No, lunch is **not provided**.

Children must bring a packed lunch and plenty of drinks.

What ages do you cater for?

The Sport Scheme is for children aged 7 to 12 years old.

Do you accept childcare vouchers?

Unfortunately, we **do not accept childcare vouchers** for payment.

How do I know my child is safe?

Your child will be looked after by **professional**, **qualified**, **and DBS-checked coaches**. Please note:

- This is an **Open Programme**, meaning staff cannot stop a child from leaving the site.
- Staff are not allowed to leave the premises.
- If a child refuses to stay on-site, parents will be contacted immediately.

What if my child has a medical condition?

Please **inform staff in advance** if your child has any medical conditions.

- A **consent form** (completed before the first day) will ask for medical details.
- You can contact us directly if you'd like to discuss how we can support your child.

Who do I contact in an emergency?

If there is an emergency, please contact the **leisure centre reception**. They will alert the **Site Lead**, who will then notify your child.
